This 4,500 s/f TriBeCa loft was originally built in 1880 as a commercial sewing factory and was later converted and restored. It features a 50 ft. south-facing frontage with original wood infrastructure, brick walls, custom built window, 11-foot ceilings and custom-milled 10 ft. wide hickory flooring. An original steel wheel from the old freight elevator remains hung on the exposed brick wall. There is a fully integrated A/V system with speakers in every room. The chef's kitchen features hand-sourced finishes from around the world. Off the centrally located family room are five bedrooms, each with a custom closet. The master suite includes a walk-in closet, dressing area. Daniel Hedaya and Cash Bernard at Platinum Properties have listed the home at \$8 million.
