
In the holiday card department, Halstead Property sent out a pretty watercolor of what looks like a prewar

Her father, Domenick, a renowned painter, bought a synagogue on Henry St. for the family's home and his studio in the late 1960s.

"I'm really impressed by A.C. Lawrence's three owners," says Turturro, who ran an acting school in the Village with her husband, Enzo. "They have integrity and look you eye to eye. We're going to stress that as we grow the firm. Young people today want to hear the truth, and we'll give it to them."
